NORFOLK, Va. (March 2007) – Norfolk International Airport (NIA) reported a .52 percent decrease in passenger activity for the month of February 2007 with 237,596 passengers. This figure compares to a February 2006 passenger count of 238,843.

For the first two months of the year, January through February 2007, passenger counts have decreased .22 percent with a total passenger count of 497,547.

In other activity, 5,490,080 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during February 2007. This represents a 4.78 percent increase from February 2006, which saw 5,239,740 pounds of cargo shipped. For the January to February time period in 2007, cargo shipments have increased 8.73 percent over the same period of time in 2006.

The above-mentioned figures are a reflection of the service by the following airlines: American, American Eagle, Continental, Continental Express, Delta, Delta Connection, Northwest, Northwest AirlinK, Southwest, United Express, US Airways and US Airways Express. Cargo carriers include Airborne, Federal Express and UPS.
