Norfolk International Airport reports on January 2009 activity

NORFOLK, Va. (Feb. 24, 2009) – Norfolk International Airport (NIA) reported a 5.61 percent decrease in passenger activity for the month of January 2009 with 236,729 passengers. This figure compares to a January 2008 passenger count of 250,796.

In other activity, 4,734,264 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during January 2009. This represents a 14.51 percent decrease from January 2008, which saw 5,537,942 pounds of cargo shipped.

The above-mentioned figures are a reflection of the service by the following airlines: American, American Eagle, Continental, Continental Express, Delta, Delta Connection, Northwest, Northwest Airlink, Southwest, United Express, US Airways and US Airways Express. Cargo carriers include Federal Express and UPS.

Norfolk International Airport (NIA) is the major airport serving southeastern Virginia with 85 daily departures provided by American, American Eagle, Continental, Continental Express, Delta, Delta Connection, Northwest, Northwest Airlink, Southwest, United Express, US Airways and US Airways Express. NIA is ranked as the 65th largest airport in the United States with over 3.5 million passengers served in 2008.
