Norfolk International Airport reports on May 2008 activity

NORFOLK, Va. (June 18, 2008) – Norfolk International Airport (NIA) reported a 3.29 percent decrease in passenger activity for the month of May 2008 with 334,378 passengers. This figure compares to a May 2007 passenger count of 345,757.

The passenger count during the five month period - January through May 2008, was 1,412,820, a 2.83 percent decrease over the same time period the previous year which saw a total passenger count of 1,453,929.

In other activity, 5,618,372 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during May 2008. This represents a 9.95 percent decrease from May 2007, which saw 6,239,118 pounds of cargo shipped. During the first five months of 2008, 27,173,971 pounds of cargo were shipped, a 5.76 percent decrease over the same time period in 2007.

The above-mentioned figures are a reflection of the service by the following airlines: American, American Eagle, Continental, Continental Express, Delta, Delta Connection, Northwest, Northwest AirlinK, Southwest, United Express, US Airways and US Airways Express. Cargo carriers include Airborne, Federal Express and UPS.
