Norfolk International Airport reports on October 2007 activity

NORFOLK, Va. (November 20, 2007) – Norfolk International Airport (NIA) reported a 0.01 percent increase in passenger activity for the month of October 2007 with 308,355 passengers. This figure compares to an October 2006 passenger count of 308,327.

For the first ten months, January through October 2007, passenger counts have increased 1.07 percent with a total passenger count of 3,138,761.

In other activity, 6,138,454 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during October 2007. This represents a 4.17 percent increase from October 2006, which saw 5,892,784 pounds of cargo shipped. For the first ten months of 2007, cargo shipments have increased 3.63 percent over the same period of time in 2006.

The above-mentioned figures are a reflection of the service by the following airlines: American, American Eagle, Continental, Continental Express, Delta, Delta Connection, Northwest, Northwest Airlink, Southwest, United Express, US Airways and US Airways Express. Cargo carriers include Airborne, Federal Express and UPS.
