Norfolk International Airport reports on March 2014 activity

NORFOLK, Va. – (Amended April 21, 2014) – Norfolk International Airport (ORF) reported a 0.74 percent increase in passenger activity for the month of March 2014 with 245,173 passengers. This figure compares to a March 2013 passenger count of 243,373. For the January - March 2014 period, passenger activity has decreased 0.90 percent versus the corresponding period in 2013.

In other activity, 4,353,773 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during March 2014. This represents a 19.68 percent decrease versus March 2013, which saw 5,420,206 pounds of cargo shipped. For the January - March 2014 period, cargo activity has decreased 18.30 percent versus the corresponding period in 2013.

The above-mentioned figures are a reflection of the service by the following airlines: AirTran, American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. Cargo carriers include Federal Express, Mountain Air Cargo and UPS.

Norfolk International Airport (ORF) is the major airport serving Coastal Virginia and Northeast North Carolina with 68 daily departures provided by Air Tran, American, Delta, Southwest, United, US Airways and their regional airline partners. According to the FAA, ORF is ranked as the 67th largest primary airport in the United States (2012) with over 3.1 million scheduled passengers served in 2013.
