Norfolk International Airport Reports on April 2024 Activity

NORFOLK, Va. - (May 14, 2024) – Norfolk International Airport (ORF) reported a 5.5 percent increase in passenger activity for April 2024 with 394,447 passengers. This figure compares to an April 2023 passenger count of 373,734. Last month was the busiest April in the airport's history and was the 15th consecutive month of record-setting passenger activity. January to April 2024 total passenger count increased 10.1 percent representing 1,371,414 passengers compared to 1,245,840 passengers during the same period in 2023.

In other activity, 3,888,008 pounds of cargo were shipped in and out of the airport during April 2024, an 18.4 percent decrease compared the 4,767,142 pounds of cargo shipped in April 2023. January to April 2024 cargo pounds shipped decreased 24.2 percent representing 15,099,378 cargo pounds versus 19,920,681 cargo pounds during last year's first quarter.

The above-mentioned figures reflect service by scheduled airlines Allegiant, American, Breeze, Delta, Frontier, Southwest, Spirit, United and their airline partners, as well as charter airlines. All-cargo carriers include Federal Express and UPS.

Norfolk International Airport is the major airport serving coastal Virginia and northeast North Carolina, ranking in the top 13% of U.S. airports with over 4.5 million passengers and over 75,000 flight operations in 2023. Skytrax has awarded Norfolk Airport a 4-Star Regional Airport rating. Among 572 airports rated in the 2023 survey, Norfolk Airport is one of just seven 4-Star airports in the U.S. Skytrax annual ratings are known as a global benchmark of airport standards.
